- 2. You will gather materials and people, pets, etc. to recreate it. You will not use a digital medium like Photoshop to create it rather it must be real people, pets, places, and things. This will make it as close to live theatre and theatre design as possible.
- 3. You will take a photo of your creation or if you're in it you will need someone to take the picture for you.
- 4. You will save an image of the original painting, take a photo of your recreation of the painting, and then create an image of them side by side.
- 5. You will submit the image with the painting and your photo via your class's Edmodo page.
