# **Storyboard That: Abraham or Moses**

### Step 1: Website Needed: https://www.storyboardthat.com

- Try to access Storyboard That through Clever first (this will give you access to all the features of the site).
- If you can't access it through Clever, then you can go directly to the website and make a free storyboard.

### Step 2: Storyboard Setup:

- Select "Create a Storyboard"
- Select "Add/Delete Cells" from the options at the bottom of the screen.
- Choose a 3x2 grid and click "update storyboard."
- Select "Layout" from the options at the bottom of the screen. Choose the "Cell, & Description" layout.
- Use the menu items across the top (scenes, characters, textables, etc) to drag the items you want into each picture cell.

### **Step 3: Storyboard Content Directions:**

- · Choose what you want your focus to be-- Abraham Travels to Canaan or Moses and The Exodus
- Using 6 boxes, retell the events.
- In the large blank "cell," create a picture describing the event. Remember things like what part of the world these events take place in and time period when creating your picture
- In the "description" box below each cell, explain what is going on in the picture. Use the captions below to guide you.

# Event Description: Abraham Travels to Canaan- Use these bullet points for your description boxes if you choose this option.

- Fearing they may take over, the Pharaoh enslaved the Hebrews.
- Moses lead the Hebrews on a 40 year Exodus back to Israel; he received the Ten Commandments from God along the way.
